Class List

Warm-ups to be held from 7:45-9:00 and after Short Stirrup Division

Classes start at 9:00

Walk Trot Canter Division: For riders 14 years or younger. Shown at walk, trot, and canter.

1. Beginner W/T/C Equitation
2. Beginner W/T/C Pleasure

Walk Trot Division: Open to riders under age 14. Shown at walk and trot both directions of the ring.

3. Walk Trot Equitation
4. Walk Trot Pleasure

Leadline Division: Open to riders 12 years old and younger. Leader must be 14 years+. Shown at the walk and individually at the trot. Riders have the option to trot or not. Riders under age 5 must also have spotter.

5. Lead line Equitation
6. Lead line Pleasure

Musical Walk-Trot: Find a "parking spot" when music stops. With each round, a parking spot is removed, just like in musical chairs! Intended as a fun class for riders in classes 1-6.

7. Musical Ponies

Short Stirrup Division: Open to riders 14 years of age or younger. Shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions. Jump course of up to 8 Cross-Rails not exceeding 18".

8. Short Stirrup Equitation Flat
9. Short Stirrup Hunter U/S Flat
10. Short Stirrup Equitation Over Fences
11. Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences

Open Division: Open to riders under 18. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

12. Open Equitation Flat
13. Open Hunter Flat
14. Open Equitation Over Fences
15. Open Hunter Over Fences

Sit-a-Buck: \$5 additional entry fee. To be ridden with saddles. Bring your \$5 bill with you! Canter optional. Winner takes 50% of the pot, 2nd place takes 30%, and 3rd place takes 20%

16. Youth Sit-a-Buck: for riders under 14
17. Junior/Adult Sit-a-Buck: for riders 14+

Youth Pleasure Division: Riders 14 years or under.

18. Youth Pleasure: w/t/c w. light contact.
19. Youth Command Class: follow judge's commands within 3 strides to stay in. Difficulty increases as riders are eliminated.

Junior/Adult Pleasure Division: Open to riders 14+

20. J/A Pleasure: w/t/c with light contact
21. J/A Command Class: follow judge's commands within 3 strides to stay in. Difficulty increases as riders are eliminated.

Junior/Adult Walk Trot Division: Open to riders 14 and older. Shown at walk and trot both directions.

22. Adult Walk Trot Equitation
23. Adult Walk Trot Pleasure

Adult Division: Shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions. Open to riders 18 and over. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

24. Adult W/T/C Equitation Flat
25. Adult Hunter Under Saddle
26. Adult Equitation Over Fences
27. Adult Hunter Over Fences

Jumper Division: Classes are judged on time, but riders may ride at any speed they choose.

28. Jumpers: jumps not to exceed 2'3"
29. Gambler's Choice: Design your own course! Jumps will have points assigned, riders have 90 seconds to complete as many jumps as possible on course.

Information

The intent of the show committee is to include as many riders as possible.

- Classes may be split to accommodate large groups and/or multiple riders sharing a horse/pony. When a split occurs, the show committee will make every effort to split groups according to age and experience.
- Show attire is not required, but all riders must wear **helmets and boots**.
- Some **scholarships** are available to offset show entry fees. Please contact your instructor or the show committee for information.
