Class List

Warm-up 7:45-9:00 and after Short Stirrup Division

Classes start at 9:00

Fitting and Showmanship: Judged on appearance of horse: condition, grooming, braiding, tack care, & ground manners. Rider should be neat and clean- jackets optional.

1. Fitting and Showmanship

Walk Trot Canter Division: For riders 14 years or younger. Shown at walk, trot, and canter.

2. Beginner W/T/C Equitation
3. Beginner W/T/C Pleasure
4. Beginner W/T Ground Poles

Walk Trot Division: Open to riders under age 14. Shown at walk and trot both directions of the ring.

5. Walk Trot Equitation
6. Walk Trot Pleasure
7. Musical Walk Trot: Find a "parking spot" when music stops. With each round, a parking spot is removed, just like in musical chairs!

Leadline Division: Open to riders 12 years old and younger. Leader must be 14 years+. Shown at the walk and individually at the trot. Riders under age 5 must have spotter.

8. Lead line Equitation
9. Lead line Pleasure

Short Stirrup Division: Open to riders 14 years of age or younger. Shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions. Jump course of up to 8 Cross-Rails not exceeding 18".

10. Short Stirrup Equitation Flat
11. Short Stirrup Hunter U/S Flat
12. Short Stirrup Equitation Over Fences
13. Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences

Sit-a-Buck: \$5 additional fee. To be ridden with saddles. Canter optional. Winner takes 50% of the pot, 2nd place takes 30%, and 3rd place takes 20%

14. Youth Sit-a-Buck: for riders under 14
15. Junior/Adult Sit-a-Buck: for riders 14+

Youth Pleasure Division: Riders 14 years or under.

16. Youth Pleasure: w/t/c w. light contact.
17. Youth Trick or Treat Transitions: w/t/c/g/back, judged on speed & smoothness of transitions.

Junior/Adult Pleasure Division: Open to riders 14+

18. J/A Pleasure: w/t/c with light contact
19. J/A Trick or Treat Transitions: w/t/c/g/back, judged on speed & smoothness of transitions.

Junior/Adult Walk Trot Division: Open to riders 14 and older. Shown at walk and trot both directions.

20. Adult Walk Trot Equitation
21. Adult Walk Trot Pleasure

Open Division: Open to riders under 18. Fences up to 2'3".

22. Open Equitation Flat
23. Open Hunter Flat
24. Open Equitation Over Fences
25. Open Hunter Over Fences

Adult Division: Shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions. Open to riders 18 and over. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

26. Adult W/T/C Equitation Flat
27. Adult Hunter Under Saddle
28. Adult Equitation Over Fences
29. Adult Hunter Over Fences

Hack Division: Shown at walk, trot, canter, hand gallop.

30. Show Hack: Judged on collection, transitions, & horse's alert expression and impulsion. Collected, working, extended trots & hand gallop.

31. Hunter Hack: Horse is forward and works well on the bit. Judged at walk, trot, hand gallop and over 1-2 fences.

32. Green Horse Hack: Walk, trot, canter, simple changes, trotting poles, circles, and two small fences. Once horse in the ring at a time.

GAMES

33. Crepe Paper Pairs: Two horses ride in sync, with riders holding a piece of crepe.

34. Egg and Spoon: See how long you can ride while holding an egg and spoon in one hand.

35. Izzy Dizzy: From start line, ride pony to a marked location. Dismount, hand off pony. Put head on bat, spin 7 full circles, then RUN back to start line.

36. Wheelbarrow Race: From start line, two riders ride pony to marked location. Hand pony to a person. One rider gets into wheelbarrow and is pushed back to start.

37. Costume Class

38. Apple Bobbing: Ride pony to a marked location. Dis mount, hand pony off. Time ends when you successfully have an apple in your mouth! Bring a towel!

Information

The intent of the show committee is to include as many riders as possible.

- Classes may be split to accommodate large groups and/or multiple riders sharing a horse/pony. When a split occurs, the show committee will make every effort to split groups according to age and experience.
- Show attire is not required, but all riders must wear **helmets and boots**.
- Some **scholarships** are available to offset show entry fees. Please contact your instructor or the show committee for information.

Release: Every entry at the Martha's Vineyard Horse Council, Inc. competition or clinic shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that all participants (which include without limitation the owner, lessee, trainer, coach, rider, handler and the horse) for themselves, their principles, representatives, employees and agents: (1) shall be subject to the rules of the MVHC, Inc. and USA Equestrian, (2) agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition, involve inherent dangerous risk of injury or death, and the MV Agricultural Society harmless from and against all claims including for any injury or loss suffered during or in these competitions, whether or not such claim injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omission of said officials, directors, members of MVAS, (3) entrants further contend that their horse has been immunized against all necessary communicable diseases and **enclose proof of immunization and copy of the horse's most recent coggins certificate.**
